New Soho star to open: Manhattan Skyline.

The new rental, 55 Thompson, is about to open at the corner of Thompson and Brocme Streets.

Once home to the City's first indoor garage (circa 1920), a curved structure, with 38 units and a throostory, family-sized townhouse now grace the site.

In a nod to its past though, a terracotta medallion of a Model T Ford that had once graced the front of the garage now crowns the nine-story building.

55 Thompson, developed by Manhattan Skyline, features one-, two-, and three-bedroom residences.

Designed by the Stephen B. Jacobs Group, the homes have solid limed white-oak flooring, 10-foot ceilings, large rooms, abundant closets and roomsized windows.

Select units are equipped with gas fireplaces, private balconies and wrap-around terraces.

According to Richard Cantor, a principal of Cantor Pecorella, the firm handling exclusive rentals and marketing for the project, "55 Thompson retains the low-rise European character of SoHo, offering renters ultimate privacy and a boutique feeling usually only found in condo buildings."

55 Thompson is expected to be ready for occupancy this fall.
